Recognizing Pvt. Gardner Homer Louden

Pvt. Gardner Homer Louden, the last Civil War veteran buried in Freeborn County, will be honored in a ceremony conducted by SUVCW William Colvill Camp #56, Department of Wisconsin. Private Louden's descendants are most cordially invited to attend as special guests. The ceremony will feature the Last Union Veteran dedication ritual of the SUVCW including the placing of a Last Union Veteran Marker on the veteran's grave.



Gardner Homer Louden was born in Dane County Wisconsin on October 3, 1848. He enlisted on August 12, 1864 as a Private and mustered into "F" Company, 4th Minnesota Infantry. He was mustered out on June 12, 1865. He passed away in Glenville, MN on January 31, 1939, at the age of 90.
